The new academic session is a wonderful time for focusing new hopes and renewed dreams. Keeping this in our mind, we wish to draw your attention to list a few points which are mentioned below:

1. Declaration of Results 2017-18: 17/3/2018 (9.00 am to 12.30pm)

2. Beginning of the New Academic session 2018-19: 21/3/2018

Summer School timings class 1 to 12: Reporting time 7.45 am Departure time: 1.45 pm

Winter School timings class 1 to 12 : Reporting time 8.45 am Departure time: 2.45 pm

3. The students are to switch over to new summer uniform: 21/3/2018

4. Summer Holidays for classes from Class 1 to 9 and 11: From 29/4/2018 to 1/7/2018
School reopens after summer break: 2/7/2018

5. It is compulsory for all students to bring the Student's Handbook every day. You are requested to check your ward's haircut, uniform, nails, punctuality, books according to the time table and to carefully read and adhere the rules and regulations mentioned in it. **Please do not provide two-wheeler to your child unless if they have valid license.**

6. Text Books and uniform for the new session 2018–2019 for all Classes will be available at the leading shops at Gwalior. **Kindly insist that your child comes to school in the proper prescribed school uniform.**

7. You are requested to ensure that all rules laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court are adhered to and that vehicles are not overcrowded and are safe for the students' travel, if you are arranging private transport. **Please instruct the Transporter concerned that the Students must be in time for the Morning Assembly every day – failing which they will be sent home immediately.**

To ensure the safety and security of your child, **please fill in the details mentioned in the Student's Handbook.** Please stick a passport size photograph of each parent in the given space. Kindly inform the **school through written application addressed to class teacher concerned** in case there is a **change** in your **address, email** and **mobile or telephone number.**

8. Electronic devices like, Mobile phone, iPod etc., Fidget spinners, toys and polythene bags are not permitted inside the school building.

9. You will receive the School Planner on 21st March 2018 which gives the details of tests/examination, competitions, activities, the list of holidays of the school and the dates when the Parent Teacher Meetings are scheduled. No separate circulars will be sent regarding the information given in the School Year Planner.

10. Last year, we have observed that some of our students who come to school empty stomach and often complain of headache during assembly. Kindly ensure child has a nutritious breakfast before coming to school

11. Few students are in practice of coming **late** every morning after the commencement of the morning assembly. Therefore, Kindly **take necessary steps to ensure that your child reaches school in time for the morning assembly or such student will be sent back home.**

Furthermore, to prevent students from wandering and wasting their time on the road after dismissal, insist that the conveyances arranged by you come exactly on time to pick up from school campus. Parents please instruct your child to be inside the school campus till their vehicle comes to pick them up.

12. Parents of class 8 pass out (2017-18) are requested to give careful thought before choosing the subjects for ICSE 2020. A separate circular is enclosed for this purpose.

Please bear in mind the following important points:

1. **Interest and ability of your ward** while deciding the choice of subjects.
2. **Avoid forcing your interest** to choose subjects in which they have no interest.
3. Consider **your ward's career interest** than the past academic performance at school while making the decisions.
4. Choose the subjects which offer many **career opportunities in the future scenario not present job opportunities**.
