- 3. Text Books and uniform for the new session 2023–2024 for all Classes will be available at the leading shops at Gwalior.
- 4. Kindly insist that your child comes to school in the proper prescribed school uniform.
- 5. Please do not provide two-wheelers to your child unless s/he has valid license.
- 6. Parents sending their children by private transport must ensure that all rules laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court are adhered to and that vehicles are not overcrowded and are safe for the students' travel. Please instruct the Transporter concerned that the Students must be in time for the Morning Assembly.
- 7. Electronic devices like, Mobile phone, iPod etc., Fidget spinners, toys and polythene bags are not permitted inside the school building.
- 8. We have observed that some of our students who come to school empty stomach and often complain of headache during assembly. Kindly ensure that child has a nutritious breakfast before coming to school.
- **9.** Parents should ensure that their child carries books and notebooks as per the given timetable to restrict the number of text books and note books being brought to the school on a daily basis so as to reduce the load of the school bag thereby making 'Learning without Burden'
- 10. Parents may kindly take necessary steps to ensure that their child reaches school in time for the morning assembly as the school gate closes by 7:30 am. Furthermore, to prevent students from wandering and wasting their time on the road after dismissal, insist that the conveyances arranged by you come exactly on time to pick up your child from school campus.
