Important Note for Students

All Holiday Homework should be done neatly and subject-wise in the following way:

- i) English, Hindi, EVS, Computer and Mathematics homework should be done in their respective subject notebooks.
- ii) Complete your work neatly and creatively. Use colors wherever needed (especially in creative tasks like drawing or posters).
- iii) Submit your homework on the day school reopens.

Parents are requested to encourage and guide the children, but let them do the work on their own.

English:

1. **Read a storybook** every week (examples: *Mogli the Jungle Boy*, *Panchtantra tales*).
2. **Word Journal** – Write 2 new words you learn every day. Use each in a sentence and draw a picture.
3. **My Summer Diary** – Write 3-4 lines each day about your day or something fun you did.

Hindi:

1. लेखन कार्य:

2. मौखिक अभ्यास:

- ii) दैनिक दिनचर्या (Daily routine) को 5 वाक्यों में बोलें

3. रचनात्मक कार्य:

Mathematics:

1. **Number Writing** – Write numbers 1 to 200 (20 per day).
2. **Practice tables** of 2 to 5 (chant, write, or sing).
3. **Shape Hunt** – Find and draw 3D shapes around the house like cubes, spheres, and cones.

EVS (Environmental Studies):

1. **My Family & Me** – Create a family tree and write 1 line about each member.
2. **My Neighborhood** – Draw or take pictures of your neighborhood and label important places (park, school, shop).

Computers

Topic: Getting to Know Computers

1. Write the **names of 5 input devices** and **2 output devices**.
2. Draw or paste pictures of any **2 computer-related tools** (mouse, printer, headphones).

Creative Corner:

1. **Clay Modeling** – Make fruits, vegetables, or animals using clay or dough.
