Important Note for Students

All Holiday Homework should be done neatly and subject-wise in the following way:

- i) English, Hindi, EVS, Computer and Mathematics homework should be done in their respective subject notebooks.
- ii) Complete your work neatly and creatively. Use colors wherever needed (especially in creative tasks like drawing or posters).
- iii) Submit your homework on the day school reopens.

Parents are requested to encourage and guide the children, but let them do the work on their own.

English:

1. **Reading Time!** – Read any 1 storybook each week (*Akbar-Birbal Tales, Geronimo Stilton, Sudha Murty stories*).
2. **Word Power** – Learn 2 new words daily. Write their meanings and make a sentence with each.
3. **My Holiday Journal** – Write 5 lines every alternate day about what you did or something new you tried.
4. **Book Review** – Write a short review of your favorite storybook. Mention the title, characters, your favorite part, and what you learned.

Hindi:

1. लेखन कार्य:

Mathematics:

1. **Tables Practice** – From 2 to 10 (write and chant).
2. **Mental Math** – Solve 5 sums daily involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.
3. **Time & Money** – Learn to read the clock and count currency (practice using play money or real coins).
4. **Math in Real Life** – Help measure ingredients while cooking, calculate grocery bills, or track dates on a calendar.

Science:

1. **Plant a Sapling** – Water it daily and observe its growth. Make a weekly observation chart.
2. **My Body, My Health** – Draw a chart of 5 healthy habits and follow them!
3. **Weather Diary** – Record the weather for 10 days (Sunny, Cloudy, Rainy, Windy).

Social Studies

1. Project Work:

Topic: *My City / My Village*

Make a colorful chart or scrapbook page with:

- i) Name of your city or village
- ii) Famous places nearby
- iii) Traditional food and clothes
- iv) One festival celebrated there

2. Map Activity:

Mark and name 5 Indian states and their capitals on a map of India.

3. Drawing Activity:

Draw the Solar System and label the planets.

Computer

Topic: Uses and Types of Computers

1. Write **any 5 uses of computers** in daily life (with illustrations if possible).
2. Draw or describe **different types of computers** (desktop, laptop, tablet, etc.).
3. Make a **chart of computer lab rules** (minimum 5 rules)

Creative Corner:

1. **Craft Time** – Use recycled materials (bottles, boxes, newspaper) to make a pencil holder or toy.
