### **Important Note for Students**

All Holiday Homework should be done neatly and subject-wise in the following way:

- i) English, Hindi, EVS, Computer and Mathematics homework should be done in their respective subject notebooks.
- ii) Complete your work neatly and creatively. Use colors wherever needed (especially in creative tasks like drawing or posters).
- iii) Submit your homework on the day school reopens.

Parents are requested to encourage and guide the children, but let them do the work on their own.

### English:

- i) **Read & Reflect** – Read at least 2 books during the holidays (*The Magic Tree House, Sudha Murty's stories, Roald Dahl books*).
- ii) **My Daily Journal** – Write a short diary entry (5–6 lines) every alternate day about something you did or observed.
- iii) **Creative Writing**  
Write a short story (8–10 lines) titled "*The Day I Became Invisible*"
- iv) **New Words Log** – Learn 2 new English words every day and use them in your own sentence.

### Hindi

### Mathematics:

- i) **Tables Practice** – Learn and revise tables from 2 to 12.
- ii) **Fun with Numbers – Practice:**
  - a)  $2\text{-digit} \times 1\text{-digit}$  multiplication
  - b)  $3\text{-digit} \div 1\text{-digit}$  division
- iii) **Word problems (2 per week)**
- iv) **Money Matters** – Make a pretend shopping list and calculate the total using real prices from grocery flyers or online stores.

### Science

- i) **Plant Care** – Grow a plant, name it, water it daily, and keep a weekly observation journal with drawings.
- ii) **My Family Chart** – Make a chart showing your family members, their favorite food, and hobbies.

**iii) Save Earth Poster** – Create a colorful poster with eco-friendly tips (e.g., “Switch off lights”, “Use less plastic”).

- ii) The religion or region they are associated with 2-3 lines on how they are celebrated
