### **Important Note for Students**

All Holiday Homework should be done neatly and subject-wise in the following way:

- Complete your work neatly and creatively. Use colors wherever needed (especially in creative tasks like drawing or posters).

Parents are requested to encourage and guide the children, but let them do the work on their own.

### **English:**

- Read & Reflect** – Read at least **2 storybooks** (Suggestions: *The Secret Seven*, *Sudha Murty's Stories*, *Charlotte's Web*).

Write a short review of each (Title, Main Characters, What you liked).

- Creative Writing**

- Write a story starting with: *"One sunny morning, I woke up and found a treasure map under my pillow..."*
- Write a letter to your future self about your goals and dreams.

- Grammar Practice**

Practice parts of speech, tenses, and punctuation (2 pages per week from your grammar book or worksheet).

- Vocabulary Builder** – Learn 2 new words daily. Use them in sentences and maintain a word diary.

### **Hindi**

3. **Mini Project** – Research any one endangered animal and write 10 facts about it with pictures or drawings.

### **1. Project File:**

**Topic:** *Freedom Fighters of India*

Make a file or scrapbook about 5 freedom fighters, including:

- i) Name & picture
- ii) 2-3 lines about their contribution to India’s freedom

### **2. Map Skills:**

Draw a political map of India and mark:

- i) 8 Indian states
- ii) their capitals
- iii) New Delhi (National Capital)

### **3. Paragraph Writing:**

**Topic:** *Importance of the Indian Constitution*

Write 100–120 words explaining why the Constitution is important in our lives.

### **4. Creative Poster:**

**Topic:** *How to be a Good Citizen*

Design a poster with at least 5 qualities or duties of a responsible citizen.
